OLWEUS (pronounced: ol-vay-us) is the bullying prevention program used by Poland CSD to support a positive school climate and educate students about social and emotional issues. Students discuss character education topics and solve problems in structured, teacher-lead discussions that remind students bullying can be prevented and corrected by:

- 1) Making an individual commitment to *not* bully others,
- 2) Helping students who are bullied,
- 3) Including students when they are left out or feel left out,
- 4) Telling an adult at home and an adult at school when you know someone is bullied.

2019-2020 topics of class meetings and planned discussion days:

- RELATIONSHIP BUILDING Be the kid who gets along with others.

OCTOBER -TOLERANCE Be the nice kid.

NOVEMBER -THOUGHTFULNESS Be the generous kid.

DECEMBER & -GROWTH MINDSET Be the resilient kid.

FEBRUARY & -BELIEVE IN YOURSELF Believe in yourself; you have good things, too.

MARCH

-RESPONSIBILITY Be the kid that does the right thing.

MAY

JUNE -CELEBRATE YOUR SUCCESS Be the kid who is happy for others.
