Faculty Room	Replaced & Tested OK
Bathroom by Room 15	Replaced & Tested OK
Fountains in Rooms 84, 85, & 87	Removed from Service
High School Boys and Girls Bathrooms	Sinks with positive lead results have been removed from service. Scheduled for full plumbing update in Capital Project.
High School Art Lab	Sinks are labeled Non-Potable. Plumbing will be replaced in Capital Project.
MS & HS Science Lab Sinks	Lab Sinks are labeled Non-Potable. Teacher station sink will be replaced to provide one drinking source in each room.
Library Office Sink	Sink is labeled Non-Potable. Plumbing will be replaced in Capital Project.

All outlets that are to be kept in service will be labeled as non-potable until they are shown to be below the NYS Action Level of 15 parts per million, according to a report from a New York State ELAP-certified laboratory.
